Hello,

GDPR covers all EU citizens, not only those who are currently located in the EU, but could also cover EU citizens who are currently on another continent (like the US).

GDPR prohibits sending of sensitive data (like DNS queries) to third parties without explicit consent. This means that if a EU citizen installs FireFox while he is in the US, and DoH is enabled by default with a 3rd party provider (Google or Cloudflare), you are possibly in violation of the GDPR.

How are you going to handle this scenario?
