My only concern with your upgrade to DoH is related to content filtering. I use a PiHole which acts as a DNS server, filters by URL and provides DoH (or DNS or TLS) for my entire network. PiHole has proven to be a very effective tool against unwanted advertising and has blinded the ISP to my URL requests.

Will Firefox ignore the DNS address that I intentionally set via DHCP in order to accomplish DoH? If I am unable to control which DNS server(s) Firefox uses, then I would be inclined to stop using it.
